Dates:

End March to end September 2013. These are the peak months at the resort.

Airport pick up:

Dates:

May to August 2013. These are the peak months at the resort.

Airport pick up:

The Resort will pick the international student up from the Airport they travel into. An emailed confirmation and greeting will be extended to the student once travel plans have been arranged and emailed to AHA placement member. Please have students try and arrive at same time.

Transportation:

Transportation is by Taxi on the island and is around \$20 one way to get around the island. A lot of our students will purchase a bike since the island is very bike friendly. Also, there are cars for sale around \$1500-\$3000 that would be very reliable and our students may split the cost of the car.

Accommodation:

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will be provided in the associate cafeteria. After the 7th day the student must have housing set for them to move from the resort to their new accommodation.

The placement hotel will assist the interns with information for rentals. The best website is <http://hiltonhead.craigslist.org/> which has a lot of rentals. The average monthly cost of rent is \$600-\$700 for a 1 bedroom or \$700 to \$900 for a 2 bedroom. A lot of the interns may share and split bedrooms for a more cost efficient living.
